

Château Bastian

History

The Château Bastian, a 14th century farm of Rivet abbey (at Auros), is a 35 hectare property, on the left bank of the Garonne.

Since 1988, it has belonged to Brigitte and Stéphane Savigneux who run the vineyard, including winemaking and marketing.

Wine making

After manual grape harvesting and traditional winemaking, these warm wines are authentic and balanced.

Soils – Geology

A 10 hectares vineyard located alongside a plateau.

Ageing :

The wine is aged in stainless steel fermentation vats, with truncated vats in thermoregulation.

Grape :30% Cabernet Franc, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon – 50%Merlot

Cellaring : 5 years

Tasting note: The color is brilliant and pure, with a beautiful ruby hue supported. The nose reveals notes of blackcurrant. The palate is rich and well structured with smooth tannins and soft.

Food:

Will be perfect with grilled or roasted meats, poultry cooked with cream and mushrooms
