



Château d'Eyran Bordeaux Rosé 2018



HISTORY

Place at the top of Saint Médard d'Eyrans, near Bordeaux, the Château Haut L'Artigue is the second wine of Château d'Eyran which dates back to the 14th century. In 1796, it became the property of the de Seze family which still possesses it today. The restoration of the vineyard has been pursued by Brigitte and Stéphane Savigneux since 1984. Their son Charles took over in 2015.

WINE MAKING


Sustainable viticultural practices, certified in Haute Valeur Environnementale Niveau 3 (High Environmental Value Level 3). After harvesting and sorting grapes by hand, this rosé is vinified in a traditional way using the saignée method.

SOILS-GEOLOGY

The 25 hectare vineyard is on a sandy and argilo-limestone ground called "graves".

GRAPE

50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 45% Merlot and 5% de Petit verdot.



CELLARING

3 years.

TASTING NOTE

An intense and elegant fruity nose. In the mouth, it reveals a good balance between aromas of citrus fruits and red fruits and a tasty freshness.

Serving temperature : 12°c

Accompaniment : Charcuterie, grilled meat, vegetable terrines. A very good aperitif wine.
